



### What You'll Need:

- 1 (thick) paper cup with the bottom cut out
- Fish tail and fins cutout (see below)
- 1 balloon tied off and cut in half
- 1 craft furry ball
- 1 thin permanent marker
- Glue
- Sticky Tape
- Scissors
- Googly eyes (or, just draw them on)

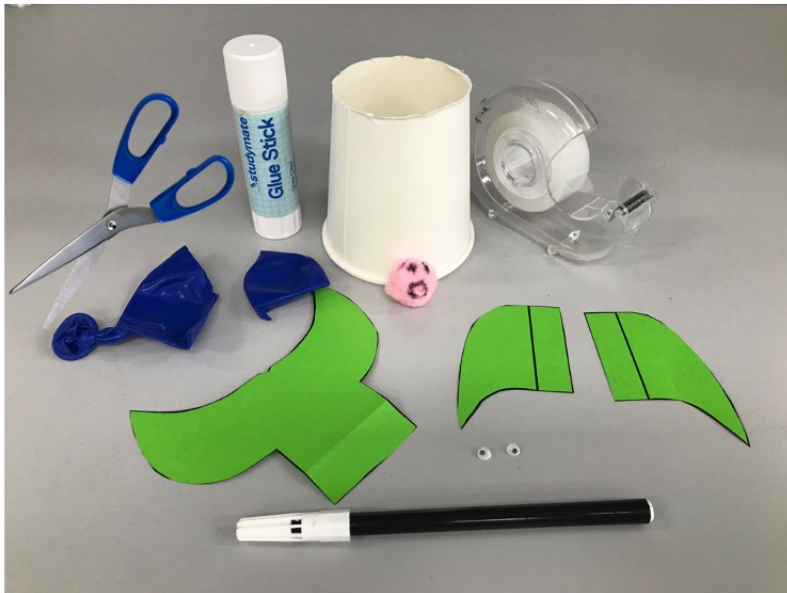
## Teachers' Prep

Prepare these harder parts in advance that the students might find a bit difficult.



### STEP #1

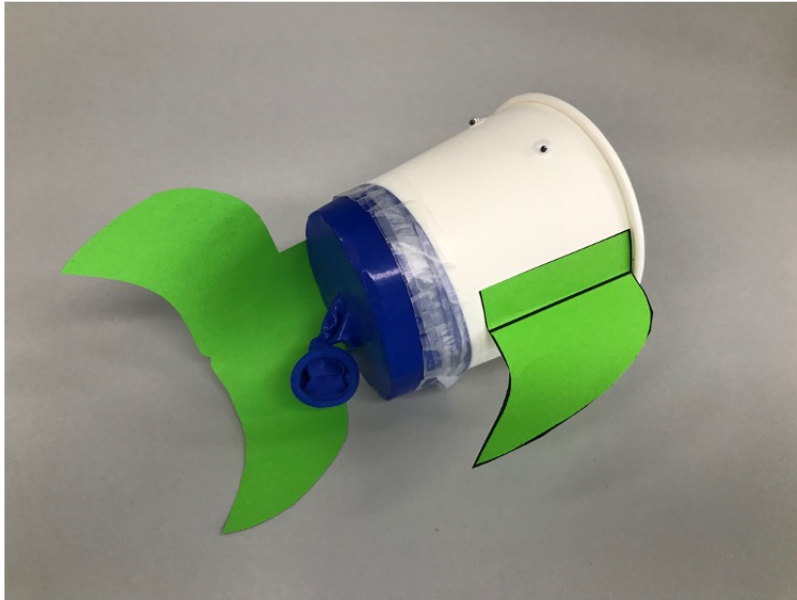
Using the thin permanent marker, draw a face onto the furry craft ball. This will be used as 'Jonah'.



### STEP #2

Cut the bottom off the cup. Tie off the balloon and cut it in half – discarding the end without the knot.

## Students' Prep



### STEP #1

Wrap the balloon on to the end of the cup and sticky tape to seal (see picture left). The cup ought to be thick enough to hold the balloon.

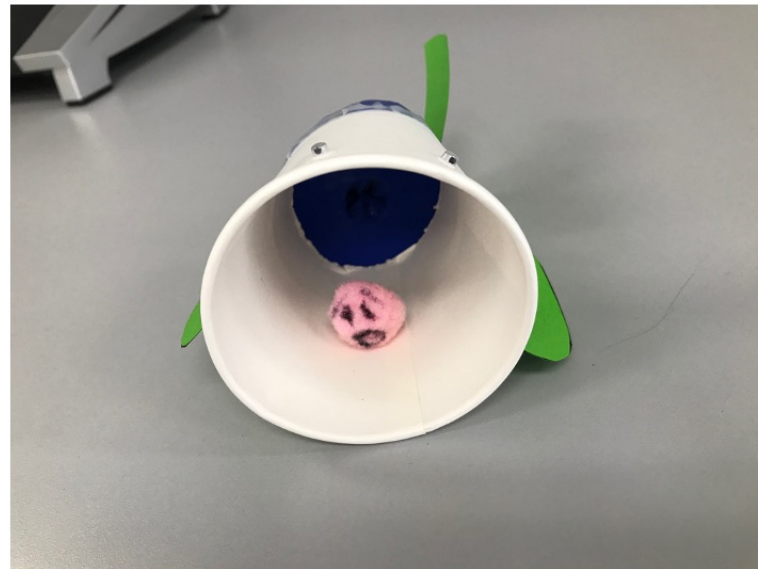
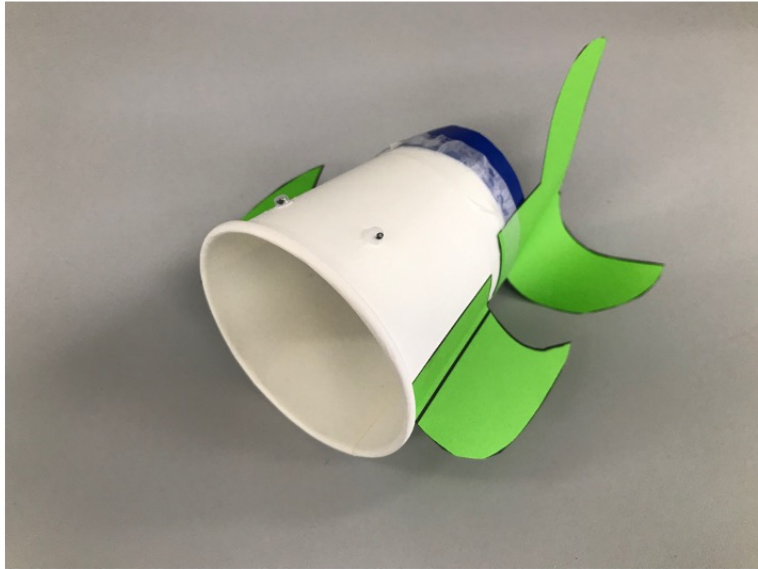
### STEP #2

Using the tail and fins cutout (see below) colour it in as you'd like. Cut out, and glue on to cup.

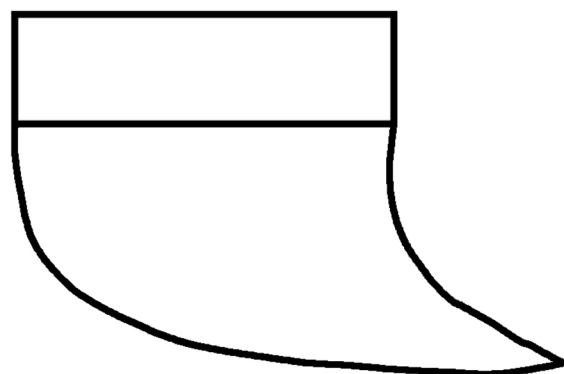
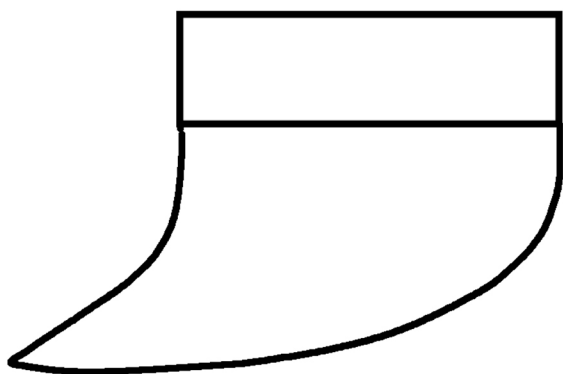
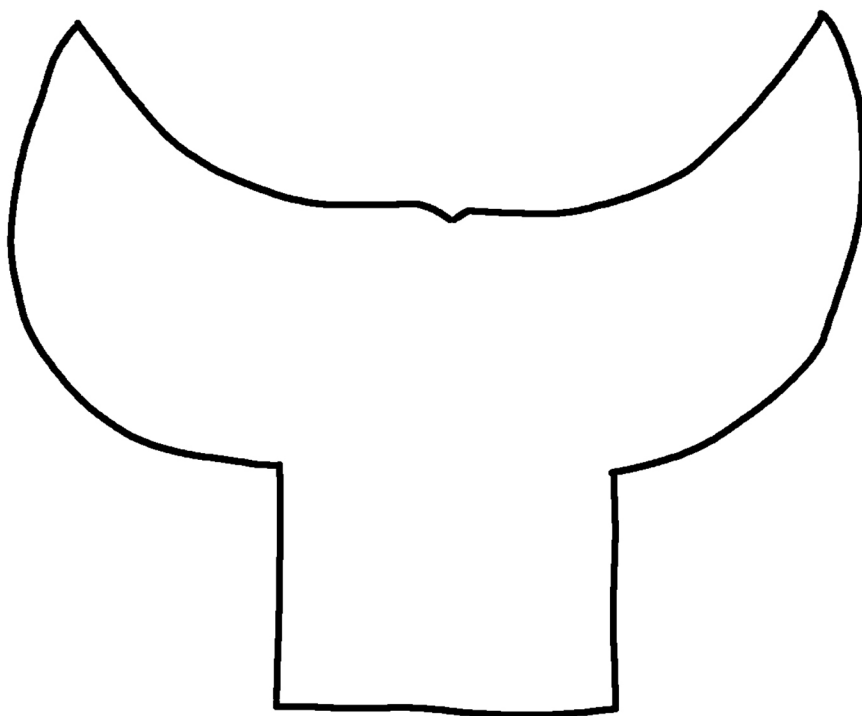
### STEP #3

Glue or draw on eyes.
